### III. Updates from SSC Chairperson - Ivette Ramos

- A. Welcome to the new parent representative, Diana Ortiz. Yvette LaValle started the meeting by congratulating Diana on her new position.

### IV. Updates from ELAC – Anaiss Servin

- A. Yvette LaValle shared that Anaiss Servin will be conducting a meeting on Tuesday, October 21. She had 8 new parents show up to the meeting. The lending library is being well used. There are more parents that are joining in on the Latino Literacy Project. And they are pursuing licences for Rosetta Stone for the members.

### V. Updates from Director of Vibrant Minds Charter School – Debra Schroeder

- A. Community School Update - Yvette shared that she met with the charter school OCDE team that assists with community school grants. They help to develop a new vision for our current situation on this campus. The sim program is up and running. Currently we have

17 primary scholars in the two day program and 8 in the upper grade, one day program. We are at 65% of people who responded to the Community School Survey. We will be making calls to strive for 100% participation. We will be pursuing a wellness center on the new campus to promote de-escalation for our scholars that need a quiet space to be at peace. We will be pivoting our focus to a strength based model and working with Mr. Bui to expand our offering for scholars to find their strengths in partnership with after-school programs.

B. Building Update - The progress is slow. The air conditioning proposal was under budgeted and the amount for HVAC will be near one million dollars. Yvette shared photos of the location and the renovation progress.

C. Security Measures - Yvette shared that the office has in place two screens for viewing the 20 cameras that are around the church campus. We are finalizing on which camera/door opening system. The front door knob has been replaced on the walking gate. It would unlock once someone would pass through it. It is now permanently locked at all times. We are working on solidifying the Pik My Kid app. There have been some issues with the number assignment to the scholars in the app. Some scholars shared the same number. We are working with the company to get this ironed out.

A. SSC Representative Report from the VMCS Board September 10, 2025 - Yvette LaValle shared that the meeting began with a presentation from Kimmie with JLL. They are the project management team that keeps the project progressing. The enrollment numbers were shared with the board members. Dr Schroeder shared proposition 28 and the arts program.
